## SECTION 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

- General advice : First aid personnel should pay attention to their own safety. Remove contaminated clothing.
- If inhaled : Remove the affected individual into fresh air and keep the person calm.  
If breathing difficulties develop, aid in breathing and seek immediate medical attention.
- In case of skin contact : Wash thoroughly with soap and water  
Under no circumstances should organic solvent be used.  
If irritation develops, seek medical attention.
- In case of eye contact : Contact lenses should be removed. Hold eyelids open and flush with copious amounts of clean, fresh water or a special eyewash solution and seek medical advice.
- If swallowed : Rinse mouth and then drink 200-300 ml of water.  
Do not induce vomiting due to aspiration hazard.  
Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor.
- Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed : Causes skin irritation.

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### SECTION 7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

- Advice on protection against fire and explosion : Keep away from open flames, hot surfaces and sources of ignition.
